As with many soccer players; the number printed on my back became my lucky number through the years and still is today. And so with the 4 U Flower it came to be all about that, for me, very lucky number.

The flower is made in 4 colors and (almost) 4 rounds.

It consists of 4 petals; that are connected with 4 FPdc2tog; back around the 4 sets of double popcorns that makes for the stamens in the very center of things. So with that I guess that there is no doubt that the number printed on my shirt was a 4.

I hope you'll like it and have a really good time, and maybe just maybe; get some extra luck from it too..

You Will Need

Sport Weight Yarn in small amounts (Yarn and Colors Must-have 50 gram / 125 mm): A - Gold (089), B - Blossom (045), C - Pearl (043) and D - Antique pink (048); C-2 / 3 mm hook (5/0); Yarn needle; Scissor

Skill level: Beginner / Intermediate

Terminology

st - stitch
rnd - round
rep - repeat
FP - Front Post
tog - together

sl st - slip stitch
ch - chain stitch
ch sp - chain space
sc - single crochet
hdc - half double crochet
dc - double crochet
tr - treble crochet
dtr - double treble crochet
p - picot*
pop - popcorn*

Picot*

ch2 + 1 sl st trough
the brackets of the
previous st

Popcorn*

work 4 dc into the same st
+ close with a ch
(that does not count
as a st on its own)

The Pattern

Please note! All rounds ends by closing with an invisible join to the second stitch.

Rnd 1 (A): 8 sc in a magic ring (8 sc)

Rnd 2 (A): Begin in any st: 1 pop in next st, 1 pop in next st + ch2); rep 4 times (8 pop + 4 ch2-sps)

Rnd 3 (B): Begin in any ch2-sp: 2 pop in next ch2-sp + ch2, skip next pop, 1 sc around the sp between next 2 pop + ch2, skip next pop); rep 4 times (8 pop + 8 ch2-sps + 4 sc)

Rnd 4 (C): Begin around a sp between any set of 2 pop:
(1 hdc + ch1 + 1 hdc) around the sp between next 2 pop,
4 hdc + sc around next ch2-sp, skip next sc,
sc + 4 hdc around next ch2-sp, skip next pop);
rep 4 times (40 hdc, 4 ch1-sp, 8 sc)

Rnd 5 (D): Begin in any first sc after a skipped one from rnd 4:
(1 sc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 hdc + 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc + 1 tr in next st, 1 tr + 1 dtr in next st, 1 dtr + p + dtr in next ch1-sp, 1 dtr + 1 tr in next st, 1 tr + 1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc + 1 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 FPdc2tog around the next set of 2 pop from rnd 2); rep 4 times (8 sc, 16 hdc, 32 dc, 16 tr, 16 dtr, 4 p, 4 FPdc2tog)

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail
