You Will Need

We have used Must-have by Yarn And Colors:

A: White

B: Icy Blue

C: Eucalyptus

D: Pearl

E: Golden

You can use any type of yarn for this square. However, we suggest a cotton for the best texture and stitch definition.

We also used a 3 mm hook, a darning needle and scissors.

Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

BLO - Back Loops Only

FP - Front Post

fo - Fasten Off

end your rnds with an invisible join to the 2nd st

sl st - slip stitch

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

pop - popcorn

(5 dc worked into the same stitch + 1 closing ch)

puff - puff stitch

(yo 4 times + 1 closing ch)

small v-st - small v-stitch

(1 dc + ch 1 + 1 dc worked into the same stitch)

large v-stitch - large v-stitch

(1 dc + ch 3 + 1 dc worked into the same stitch)

dc2tog - double crochet 2 together

(decrease)

The Pattern

Rnd 1 (A) In a magic circle: (1 dc2tog + ch 1) x 8 times, fo - 8 dc2tog, 8 ch1-sps

Rnd 2 (B) - Begin in any given ch1-sp:

*2 sc + ch 3 + 2 sc in the next ch1-sp, 1 FPsc around the next st; rep from * til end, fo

- 32 sc, 8 ch3-sps, 8 FPsc

Rnd 3 (C) - Begin in any given FPsc:

*1 small v-st in the next st, skip the next st, 1 BPsc around the next st, ch 1, 1 BPsc around the next st, skip the next st; rep from * til end, fo

- 8 small v-sts, 16 BPsc, 8 ch1-sps

Rnd 4 (D) - Note. The puff stitches are worked around the ch1-sp of the V-sts. Begin around any given ch1-sp placed between 2 BPscs:

*1 small v-st around the next ch1-sp + ch 1, skip the next st, 1 puff in the next st, ch 1; rep from * til end, fo

- 8 small v-sts, 16 ch1-sps, 8 puffs

Rnd 5 (A) - Work around the ch1-sp of the small v-sts, begin around any given:

*2 sc + ch 3 + 2 sc around the next st, 2 sc in the space between the sts, skip the next st, 2 sc in the space between sts; rep from * til end, fo

- 64 sc, 8 ch3-sps

Rnd 6 (B) - Begin in the sp between any given set of 2 sc placed next to a puff st:

*1 dc + ch 1 x 5 times in the next space between the 2 sc, skip the next 4 sts, going from the back of round 4 and in the middle between the scs: 1 sl st + ch 1 around the ch1-sp of the small v-st, skip the next ch3-sp and the next 4 sc; rep from * til end, fo

- 40 dc, 48 ch1-sps, 8 sl sts

Rnd 7 (D) - Note. For this rnd you will only be working in the ch3-sps from rnd 5 and the 3rd of the 5 dc-sets from rnd 6. Begin around any given ch3-sp from rnd 5:

*(dc2tog + ch 1) x 3 times + dc2tog + ch 2 around next ch3-sp from rnd 5, 1 sc in the top of the 3rd dc of 5 from rnd 6, ch 2; rep from * til end, fo

- 32 dc2tog, 24 ch1-sps, 16 ch2-sps, 8 sc

Rnd 8 (A) - Begin around any given sc:

*FPsc around the next st; 2 sc around the next ch2-sp, (FPhdc around the next st, sc around the next ch1-sp) x 3 times, FPhdc around the next st, 2 sc around the next ch2-sp; rep from * til end, fo - 8 FPsc, 56 sc, 32 FPhdc

Rnd 9 (C) - Begin in any given first FPhdc:

*1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 3 sts, skip the next 2 sts, ch 2, FPsc around the FPsc, skip the next 2 sts, ch 2, 1 sc in the next 3 sts, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, ch 2, skip the next 2 sts, large v-st in the next st (i.e. the fpsc), ch 2, skip the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, fo

- 16 dc, 16 hdc, 24 sc, 16 ch2-sps, 4 FPsc, 4 large v-sts

#PatchOfPoises #WhatWereYouThinkingSquare Rnd 10 (E) - Independent round! Begin in any given last dc before a corner:

*1 sl st in the next st, skip the next 3 sts (i.e. the ch2-sp and dc), (1 dc + ch 1) x 5 times + dc in the next ch3-sp, skip the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in the next st, fo; rep in all 4 corners - 24 dc, 20 ch-1sps, 8 sl sts

Rnd 11 (D) - Work in both rnd 10 and 9. Begin in any given first dc from rnd 10:

*(1 sc in the next st, 1 sc around the next ch1-sp) x 2, 1 sc in the next st, 1 sc + ch 1 + 1 sc around the next ch1-sp, (1 sc in the next st, 1 sc around the next ch1-sp) x 2 times, 1 sc in the next st, **continue on rnd 9:** 1 dc in the next st (which already holds a sl st from rnd 10), 1 hdc in the next 6 sts, skip the next ch2-sp, 1 large FPv-st around the next st, skip the next ch2-sp, 1 hdc in the next 6 sts, 1 dc in the next st (which already holds a sl st from rnd 10); rep from * til end, fo - 8 dc, 48 sc, 4 ch1-sps, 48 hdc, 4 large FPv-sts

Rnd 12 (B) - Begin in any given ch3-sp:

*1 pop + ch 1 + 1 pop + ch 1 + pop + ch 2 around the next ch3-sp, skip the next 6 sts, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, ch 3, skip the next 3 sts, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, 1 hdc + ch 2 + 1 hdc around the next ch1-sp, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, ch 3, skip the next 3 sts, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, ch 2, skip the next 6 sts; rep from * til end, fo - 12 pop, 8 ch1-sps, 12 ch2-sps, 8 ch3-sps, 24 FPdc, 24 hdc

#PatchOfPoises #WhatWereYouThinkingSquare Rnd 13 (F) - Begin in any given corner space:

*2 dc + ch 2 + 2 dc in the next ch2-sp, skip the hidden st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 3 dc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, 3 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPtr around the FPdc from rnd 11, (1 FPsc around the next pop, 1 sc around the ch1-sp) x 2 times, 1 FPsc around the next pop, 1 FPtr around the FPdc from rnd 11, 3 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, 3 dc around the next ch2-sp, skip the hidden st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, fo

- 56 dc, 4 ch2-sps, 24 FPdc, 24 hdc, 8 FPtr, 12 FPsc, 8 sc

Rnd 14 (A) - Begin in any given ch2-sp:

*2 dc + ch 2 + 2 dc in the next ch2-sp, 1 dc in each st across the side; rep from * til end, fo

- Per side: 37 dc, 1 ch2-sp

Rnd 15 (D) - Begin in any given ch2-sp:

*2 hdc + ch 2 + 2 hdc in the next ch2-sp, 1 BLOhdc in the next 10 sts, 1 FPtr around the next 3 FPdcs from rnd 13, skip the next 3 sts in rnd 14 (the ones placed behind the newly made FPtrs), 1 BLOhdc in the next 12 sts, 1 FPtr around each of the next 3 FPdc from rnd 13, skip the next 3 sts in rnd 14 (the ones behind the newly made FPtrs), 1 BLOhdc in the next 9 sts; rep from * til end, fo

- Per side: 4 hdc, 1 ch2-sp, 31 BLOhdc, 6 FPtr

Rnd 16 (D) - Begin in any given ch2-sp:

*2 hdc + ch 2 + 2 hdc in the next ch2-sp, 1 BLOhdc in the next 12 sts, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, 1 BLOhdc in the next 12 sts, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, 1 BLOhdc in the next 11 sts; rep from * til end, fo

- Per side: 4 hdc, 1 ch2-sp, 36 BLO hdc, 6 FPdc
