You Will Need

Ilses Colorway

(seen on the front page)

A: Gold (089)

B: Blossom (045)

C: Eucalyptus (080)

D: Cream (002)

E: Salmon (039)

You can use any type of yarn for this square. However, we suggest a cotton for the best texture and stitch definition.

We also used a 3 mm hook, a darning needle and scissors.

Skill level: Intermediate

B: Light Pink (044)

C: White (001)

D: Soft Grey (065)

E: Icy Blue (063)

F: Old Pink (047)

Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

(end your rnds with an invisible join to the 2nd st)

FP - Front Post

BP - Back Post

BLO - Back Loop Only

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

puff - puff stitch

(yarn over 3 times + 1 closing ch)

mini puff - mini puff stitch

(go directly into the stitch and pull up a loop, yarn over and pull up a loop two times, yarn over and pull through all loops on the hook + 1 closing ch)

v-stitch

(1 dc + ch2 + 1 dc)

The Pattern

To begin:

rnd 1 (A/A/A)

2 sc + ch 3 x 4 times into a magic circle, fo.

- 8 sc, 4 ch3-sps

rnd 2 - (B/B/B) - start with a standing stitch in any given
*dc2tog + ch 1 x 3 times around the next ch3-sp, skip the next 2 sts;
rep from * til end, fo.

- 12 dc2tog, 4 ch1-sps

rnd 3 (C/C/C) - Begin with a standing st around any given ch1-sp
placed between two sets of 3 dc2tog:
*2 sc around the next ch1-sp, (1 FPsc around the next st, 1 sc in the
next space between sts) rep 2 times, 1 FPsc around the next st; rep
from * til end, fo.

- 16 sc, 12 FPsc

rnd 4 (D/D/D) - Begin with a standing st
Begin in any given; *1 v-st in the next st, skip the next st; rep from *
til end, fo.

- 14 v-sts

rnd 5 (E/E/B) - Note. For this rnd we will only be working around the ch2-sp of the v-sts, skip all other stitches. Begin in any given; *4 dc + ch 1 + 4 dc around the next v-st, skip the next v-st; rep from * til end, fo.

- 56 dc, 7 ch1-sps

rnd 6 (B/B/A) - Note. Work only around the ch2-sp of v-sts. Begin in any given;

*3 hdc around the next v-st + ch 4; rep from * til end, fo. Place the ch4-sps to the back of your work.

- 21 hdc, 21 ch4-sps

rnd 7 (B/F/E) - Note. For this rnd you'll be working around ch-sps from
both rnd 6 and 5. Begin in any second hdc in a set of 3 of rnd 6;
*(4 dc + ch 1 + 4 dc) in next st, skip the next st, sl st around the
next ch1-sp of rnd 5 and the next ch4-sp of rnd 6; rep from * til
end, fo.

- 56 dc, 7 ch1-sps

rnd 8 (D/D/D) - Note. For this rnd you'll be working in both rnd 7 and 6. Begin in any given;

*1 sc around the next ch1-sp of rnd 7, 8 dc around the next ch4-sp of rnd 6 (4 before sl st and 4 after); rep from * til end, fo.

- 7 sc and 56 dc

rnd 9 (D/D/F) - Begin in any given sc;
*1 v-st in the next st, skip the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- 21 v-sts

rnd 10 (C/B/B) - Note. For this round you are working around the ch2-sps of the v-st and the spaces between them. Skip the legs (i.e. the dcs). It may look like a complicated round but it's really simple. You just have to make sure that you have 21 hdcs per side and a corner ch2 and then you're good.

Place your flower as you wish it to be positioned for your square; then begin in the v-st placed above the petal on top:

(3 hdc around the next ch2-sp, skip the next st, 1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip the next st) x 3 times, ch 2,

(skip the next st, 3 hdc around the next ch2-sp, skip the next st, 1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip the next st) x 5 times, 1 hdc in the next ch2-sp, ch 2,

2 hdc in same ch2-sp, skip the next st, 1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, (3 hdc in the next ch2-sp, skip the next st, 1 hdc round the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip next st) x 4, skip the next st, 2 hdc in the next ch2-sp, ch 2,

1 hdc in the same ch2-sp, (1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip the next st, 3 hdc in the next ch2-sp, skip the next st) x 5, ch 2

(1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip the next st, 3 hdc in the next ch2-sp, skip the next st) x 2, 1 hdc around the next sp between 2 v-sts, skip the next st, fo.

- Per side: 21 hdc, 1 ch2-sp

rnd 11 (C/B/D) - Begin around any given;

*2 hdc + ch 2 + 2 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts, 1 FPhdc around the next 4 sts, 1 FPsc around the next 7 sts, 1 FPhdc around the next 4 sts, 1 FPdc around the next 3 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 4 hdc, 1 ch2-sp, 6 FPdc, 8 FPhdc, 7 FPsc

rnd 12 (B+A/E+F/A+E) - Note. For this round you'll be color changing
between color A and B. Begin with color B in any given;
*1 dc2tog + ch 1 + 1 dc2tog + ch1 + 1 dc2tog around the next ch2-sp
whilst changing to color A in the final pull trough of the last dc2tog,

skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 10 sts whilst changing back to color B in the final pull trough of the last hdc,

skip the next st, 1 dc2tog + ch1 + 1 dc2tog + ch 1 + 1 dc2tog in the next st, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 10 sts whilst changing back to color A in the final pull trough of the last dc2tog,

skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 10 sts whilst changing back to color B in the final pull trough of the last hdc; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 6 dc2tog, 4 ch1-sps, 20 hdc

rnd 13 (E/C/C) - Begin in any first hdc after a corner;

*1 FPdc around the next 10 sts, 1 FPhdc around the next st, ch 1, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPsc around the next st, ch 1, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPhdc around the next st, 1 FPdc around the next 10 sts, 1 FPhdc around the next st, ch1, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPsc around the next st, ch1, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPhdc around the next st; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 4 FPhdc, 4 ch1-sps, 2 FPsc, 20 FPdc

- rnd 14 (D/D/B) Note. The mini puffs and puffs for this round are worked around both ch1-sps from rnd 13 and 12. Begin in any first FPdc after a corner;
- *1 BPdc around the next 10 sts, skip the next st (FPhdc), 2 mini puffs around the ch1-sps, 2 mini puffs around the next ch1-sps, skip the next st (FPhdc), 1 BPdc around the next 10 sts, skip the next st (FPhdc), 2 puffs between the next dc2tog, ch 2, 2 puffs between the next dc2tog; rep from * til end, fo.
- Per side: 20 BPdc, 4 mini puffs, 4 puffs, 1 ch2-sp
- rnd 15 (B/E/F) Note. For this rnd we'll be working in stitches from both rnd 14 and 12. Begin around any first puff after a corner on rnd 14; *1 FPhdc around the next st, 1 hdc around the space between the puffs, 1 FPhdc around the next st, 3 dc + ch 1 + 3 dc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPhdc around the next st, 1 hdc around the space between the puffs, 1 FPhdc around the next st, 1 sc in the next st, ch 4, 1 sc behind your work in the fifth dc from rnd 12, ch 4, 1 sc in the last dc before the next puff on rnd 14, place the ch4-sp behind the puffs, 1 sc in the next st, ch 4, 1 sc in the last dc before the corner puff on rnd 14; rep from * til end, fo.
- Per side: 6 dc, 1 ch1-sp, 6 sc, 5 ch4-sps, 2 hdc, 4 FPhdc
- rnd 16 (C/C/C) Note. We'll be working in sts from both rnd 14 and 15. Begin in any given corner ch1-sp from rnd 15;
- *1 sc + ch 1+ 1 sc around the next ch1-sp, 1 BPsc around the next 6 sts, skip the next st,
- 1 FPhdc around the first 3 sts of rnd 14, 1 hdc in around the next ch4-sp of rnd 15, 1 hdc in the sc, 3 hdc around the next ch4-sp, skip the next 5 sts of rnd 14, 1 FPhdc in the last 2 sts of rnd 14,
- 1 FPsc around the next 2 sts (the mini puffs), 1 sc in the space between the puffs, 1 FPsc around the next 2 sts (the mini puffs),
- 1 FPhdc around the next 2 sts **from rnd 15**, 2 hdc around the next ch4-sp, 1 hdc in the sc, 2 hdc around the next ch4-sp, skip the next 5 sts **of rnd 14**, 1 FPhdc around the next 3 sts,
- skip the next sc **of rnd 15**, 1 BPsc around the next 6 sts; rep from * til end, fo.
- Per side: 3 sc, 1 ch1-sp, 12 BPsc, 10 FPhdc, 10 hdc, 4 FPsc

rnd 17 (A/B/E) - Begin in any given;

*1 dc + ch 2 + 1 dc around the next ch1-sp, 1 dc in the next 7 sts, 1 BLOdc (catch the third loop too) in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 19 sts, 1 BLOdc (catch the third loop too) in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 7 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 35 dc, 1 ch2-sp, 6 BLOdc

rnd 18 (B/E/P) - Note. For this rnd we will be working in both rnd 17 and 14. Begin around any given ch2-sp of rnd 17;

*1 hdc + ch 2 + 1 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 BPhdc in the next 11 sts, 5 dc in the third skipped st of rnd 14, skip the next 5 sts of rnd 17, 1 BPsc around the next 9 sts, 5 dc in the third skipped st of rnd 14, skip the next 5 sts of rnd 17, 1 BPhdc around the next 11 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 35 dc, 1 ch2-sp, 6 BLOdc

rnd 19 (D/C/E) - Begin in any given;

*1 hdc + ch 2 + 1 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 BPhdc in the next 12 sts, 1 FPdc around the next st, 1 FPhdc around the next 3 sts, 1 FPdc around the next st, 1 BPhdc around the next 9 sts, 1 FPdc around the next st, 1 FPhdc around the next 3 sts, 1 FPdc around the next st, 1 BPhdc around the next 12 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 2 hdc, 1 ch2-sp, 24 BPdc, 2 FPdc, 12 FPhdc

rnd 20 (C/D/E) - Begin in any given;

*1 sc + ch 2 + 1 sc around the next ch2-sp, 1 sl st in 45 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- Per side: 2 sc, 1 ch2-sp, 45 sl st
