Or 1 skein of

Must-have:

Ecru (003)

Or 1 skein of

Super Must-have:

Cream (002)

All above by Yarn And Colors

You can use any type of yarn for your makes. However, I suggest a cotton for the best structure and stitch definition.

I also used a 3,5 mm hook for all (but the Super Must-have for which I used a 6 mm) a long with a darning needle and scissors.

# Abbreviations

## **US-terminology**

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

(end your rnds with an invisible join to the 2nd st)

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

dcXtog - double crochet X together

(crochet 2 or 3 (X) dc together in the given st)

p - picotX

(chain 2, 3 or 4 (X) + sl st through the first ch)

## The Pattern

#### The Snowflake - Make 5

#### To begin:

Make 6 sc in a magic circle, close with a sl st to the first st

- 6 sc

rnd 1 Begin with a standing st
1 dc3tog + ch2 in each st across, close with a sl st to the first st

- 6 dc3tog, 6 ch2-sps

rnd 2 Begin with 1 sl st into next ch2-sp + ch 1
\*3 sc around next ch2-sp, ch 3, skip next dc3tog; rep from \* til end,
close with a sl st to the first sc

- 18 sc, 6 ch3-sps

**rnd 4** Note! The last sl st from previous rnd counts as the first of this rnd

\*1 sl st in next st, 1 sl st + 1 picot2 + 1 sl st in next st, 1 sl st in next st, 1 sc + 1 hdc + 1 picot3 + 1 picot4 + 1 picot3 + 1 hdc + 1 sc around next ch3-sp; rep from \* til end, fo and close with an invisible join to the second st

- 24 sl sts, 6 picot2, 12 sc, 12 hdc, 12 picot3, 6 picot4

#### The Flowers - Make 2

#### To begin:

Make 6 sc in a magic circle, close with a sl st to the first st

- 6 sc

**rnd 1** Note! The last sl st from previous rnd counts as the first of this rnd

1 sl st + ch 1 + 1 dc2tog + ch 1 + 1 sl st in each st across, fo and close with an invisible join to the second st  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

- 12 sl sts, 12 ch1-sps, 6 dc2tog

### The Triangles - Make 4

#### To begin:

Make 6 sc in a magic circle, close with a sl st to the first st

- 6 sc

**rnd 1** Note! The last sl st from previous rnd counts as the first of this rnd

(1 sl st + 1 picot3 + 1 picot4 + 1 picot3 + 1 sl st in next st, 1 sl st in next st) x 2 times, 1 sl st + 1 picot3 + 1 picot4 + 1 picot3 + 1 sl st in next st, 1 sl st + ch 2 + sl st in next st, fo and close with an invisible join to the second st

- 10 sl sts, 6 picot3, 3 picot4, 1 ch2-sp

ch 30

Attach the first triangle with a sl st through it's ch2-sp

ch 20

Attach the first snowflake with a sl st through any picot2

ch 20

Attach the second triangle with a sl st through it's ch2-sp

ch 20

Attach the second snowflake with a sl st through any picot2

ch 20

Attach the first flower with a sl st through two bars on the backside of

any petal

ch 20

Attach the third snowflake with a sl st through any picot2

ch 20

Attach the second flower with a sl st through two bars on the

backside of any petal

ch 20

Attach the forth snowflake with a sl st through any picot2

ch 20

Attach the third triangle with a sl st through it's ch2-sp

ch 20

Attach the fifth snowflake with a sl st through any picot2

ch 20

Attach the forth triangle with a sl st through it's ch2-sp

ch 30

fo
