You Will Need

Tools:

A 3 mm hook

A pair of scissors and a darning needle

Yarn:

Small amounts of 2 colors of yarn.

We have used Must-have by Yarn and colors in the shades:

A: Vanilla (010)

B: Pearl (043)

You can use practically any type of yarn that you want for this flower.

However, we suggest a cotton for the best structure and stitch

definition.



Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

End your rounds with an invisible join to the 2nd stitch

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

st ch - starting chain stitch

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

dc -double crochet

spike sc - spike single crochet

a long sc placed **over** the previous round

Please note that the starting and closing chains does not count as stitches in this pattern.

The Pattern

The flower

Rnd 1. (Vanilla)

In a magic circle make: st ch 1, 5 sc, don't tighten your circle completely yet, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 5 sc

Rnd 2. Work over rnd 1 and back into the magic circle st ch 1, 10 spike sc, fo

- 10 spike sc

Rnd 3. (Pearl) Begin in any given

*1 sl st + ch 2 + 2 dc + ch 2 + 1 sl st in each at across, fo

- 20 sl st, 20 ch2-sp, 20 dc
