You Will Need

Tools:

A 3 mm hook

An elastic hair tie

A pair of scissors and a darning needle

Varn:

15-20 gram of the Must-have cotton yarn
by Yarn and colors. We have used the colors Eucalyptus and
Cream in this pattern.

Pattern Notes

- Keep in mind that what yarn fiber you choose will affect
 the give to your headband, make it a bit smaller than your
 head to make sure it doesn't stretch too much during long
 term wear
- This pattern is highly adaptable, you can make it larger or smaller by simply adapting the number of hdc rows of it (rnd 18-46), try it as you go to make sure it fits you properly
- The finished size of the head band is 4,5 cm wide and 42 cm long unblocked and without the hair tie, with it approximately 45 cm long unstretched

Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

End your rounds with an invisible join to the 2nd stitch

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

tch - turning chain stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

The headband meausres

Please note that the turning chains does not count as stitches in this pattern.

The Pattern

Row 1. Crochet around the elastic hair tie and begin with a standing st: 6 sc, tch 1 + turn

- 6 sc

Row 2-3.

*1 sc in each st across, tch 1 + turn

- 6 sc (2 rows)

Row 4.

2 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st, tch

1 + turn

- 8 sc

Row 5-6.

*1 sc in each st across, tch 1 + turn

- 8 sc (2 rows)

Row 7.

2 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st, tch

1 + turn

- 10 sc

Row 8.

- *1 hdc in each st across, tch 1 + turn
- 10 hdc

Row 9-17.

- *1 hdc in the next 2 sts, ch 1, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 4 sts, ch 1, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, tch 1 + turn
- 8 hdc, 2 ch1-sp (9 rows)

Row 18-46.

- *1 hdc in each st across, tch 1 + turn
- 10 hdc (29 rows)

Row 47-56.

- *1 hdc in the next 2 sts, ch 1, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 4 sts, ch 1, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 2 sts, tch 1 + turn
- 8 hdc, 2 ch1-sp (9 rows)

Row 57.

- *1 hdc in each st across, tch 1 + turn
- 10 hdc

Row 58.

1 sc dec over the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 6 sts, 1 sc dec over the next 2 sts, tch 1 + turn

- 8 sc

Row 59-60.

*1 sc in each st across, tch 1 + turn

- 8 sc (2 rows)

Row 61.

1 sc dec over the next 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 4 sts, 1 sc dec over the next 2 sts, tch 1 + turn

- 6 sc

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Row 62-63.

- *1 sc in each st across, tch 1 + turn
- 6 sc (2 rows)

Fasten off your yarn whilst leaving a 20 cm long yarn tail. With the long yarn tail; sew your headband on to the hair tie using over hand stitches. Make two in each stitch and then fasten off the ends on the backside.

Reapeat for your starting yarn end and voilá:

Your Forever Love Headband is now finished!
