The Poppy Pearl Flower

You Will Need

Tools:

A 3 mm hook

A pair of scissors and a darning needle

Yarn:

Small amounts of 2 colors of yarn.

We have used Must-have by Yarn and colors in the shades:

A: Pearl (043)

B: Vanilla (010)

You can use practically any type of yarn that you want for this flower.

However, we suggest a cotton for the best structure and stitch

definition.



Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

BLO - Back Loops Only

FLO - Front Loops Only

fo - Fasten Off

End your rounds with an invisible join to the 2nd stitch

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

st ch - starting chain stitch

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc -double crochet

tr - treble crochet

Please note that the starting chains does not count as stitches in this pattern.

The Pattern

The flower base

Rnd 1. (Pearl)

In a magic circle make: st ch 1, 12 hdc, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 12 hdc

Rnd 2.

st ch 1, *1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st; rep from * til end, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 18 sc

Rnd 3. Work in the FLO of rnd 2

st ch 1, *1 hdc + 3 dc in the next st, 3 dc + 1 hdc in the next st, sl st in the next st; rep from * til end, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 12 hdc, 36 dc, 6 sl st

Rnd 4. Work in the BLO of rnd 2

st ch 1, 1 sl st + ch 3 + 1 sl st in the next 18 sts, fo

- 36 sl st, 18 ch3-sps

Rnd 5. (Vanilla) Independent round, begin around any given 1 surface sl sts around the bodies of the next 12 hdc from round 1, fo

- 12 surface sl st

The center pearl

Step 1. (Vanilla) In a magic circle make:

2 st ch, 14 dc, sl st in the first st to close and then cut off the yarn leaving a 10 cm long tail.

Step 2. Fasten of your starting thread

Step 3. Using the long end tail: sew through the 14 BLOs with overhand stitches and pull tight to form a pearl.

Step 4. Take your long end tail and see through the center of the flower, placing the pearl in the center, and attach with a overhand stitches in the FLO of the pearl and back down to the back.

Your Poppy Pearl Flower is now finished!
