# You Will Need

## Tools:

A 3 mm hook

A Pair of scissors and a darning needle

## Yarn:

Small amounts of 2 colors of yarn.

We have used Must-have by Yarn and colors in the shades:

A: Vanilla (010)

B: Pearl (043)

You can use practically any type of yarn that you want for this flower.  
However, we suggest a cotton for the best structure and stitch definition.



# Abbreviations

## **US-terminology**

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

end your rnds with an invisible join to the 2nd stitch

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc -double crochet

tr - treble crochet

p - picot

chain 2, then slip stitch through  
the brackets of the previous st

pop - popcorn

Work 4 dc into same stitch, remove the hook, insert it  
back in first of the 4 dc:s and pick up working loop, pull  
it through and close with 1 ch (does not count as a st)

***Please note that all rounds starts with a standing  
stitch.***



# The Pattern

## The flower

### Rnd 1. (Vanilla)

In a magic circle make: st ch 2, 6 pop, 1 sl st in the first st to close, cut the yarn and sew in the ends

- 6 pop

### Rnd 2. (Pearl) Begin in any pop

\*1 sc in the next st + ch 5; 1 sl st in the 2nd ch from the hook, 1 hdc in the next two ch, 1 sl st in the next ch; rep from \* til end, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 6 sc, 6 ch5-sp, 12 sl st, 12 hdc (6 petals)

*Note! The closing sl st of rnd 2 counts as the first of rnd 3*

### Rnd 3. Work behind round 2 and only into the scs

\*1 sl st + ch 3 in the next sc; rep from \* til end, 1 sl st in the first st to close

- 6 sl st, 6 ch3-sp

### Rnd 4.

\*1 sl st + 1 hdc + 1 dc + 1 tr + 1 p + 1 tr + 1 dc + 1 hdc + 1 sl st around the next ch3-sp, skip the next st; rep from \* til end, fo

- 12 sl st, 12 hdc, 12 dc, 12 tr, 6 p

*Your Purple Pop Flower  
is now finished!*
