You Will Need

5 colors of
Must-have by Yarn and Colors:

A: Pearl (043)

B: Mustard (015)

C: Old Pink (047)

D: Cream (002)

E: Antique Pink (048)

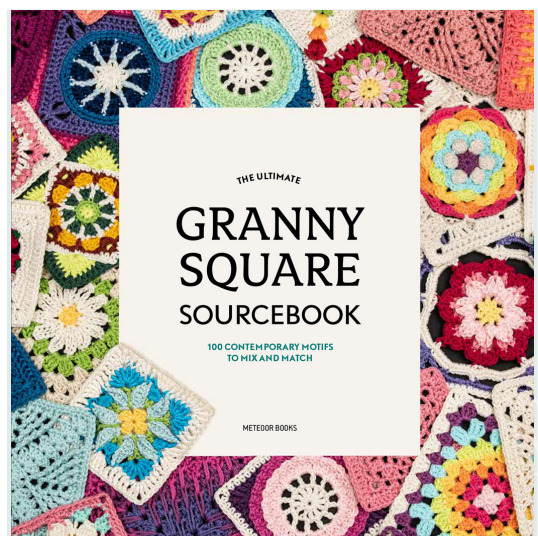
You can use any type of yarn for this square. However, we suggest a cotton for the best texture and stitch definition.

We also used a 3 mm hook, a darning needle and scissors.

Abbreviations

US-terminology

st - stitch

rnd - round

fo - Fasten Off

(end your rnds with an invisible join to the 2nd st)

FP - Front Post

BP - Back Post

ch - chain stitch

ch sp - chain space

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

5-dc-pc - 5 double crochet popcorn stitch

(5 double crochet popcorn + 1 closing ch)

3-dc-pc - 3 double crochet popcorn stitch

(3 double crochet popcorn + 1 closing ch)

3-dc-bobble - 3 double crochet bobble stitch

(3 double crochet bobble stitch)

3-tr-bobble - 3 treble crochet bobble stitch

(3 treble crochet bobble stitch)

The Pattern

rnd 1 (A) Begin in a magic circle:

8 sc, 1 sl st in the initial sc to close the rnd.

- 8 sc

rnd 2 - (A) Begin with a standing st:

*2 3-dc-pc in the next st + ch 1; rep from * til end, fo.

- 16 3-dc-pop, 8 ch1-sps

rnd 3 (B) Begin in any ch-1-space placed between 2 groups of 3-dc-pc sts, make your first stitch a standing st:

*(3 hdc around next ch-1-space, skip the next st, 2 hdc around the space between the next two 3-dc-pc sts, skip the next st); rep from * til end, fo.

- 40 hdc

rnd 4 (C) Begin with a standing st around any given:

1 BPhdc around the next 40 sts, fo.

- 40 BPhdc

rnd 5 (D) Begin with a standing stitch in any given:

*1 3-dc-bobble in the next st + ch 3, 1 3-tr-bobble in the next st + ch 3, 1 3-dc-bobble in the next st + ch 1, skip the next 2 sts, 1 5-dc-pc in next 3 st, ch 1, skip the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- 8 3-dc-bobbles, 8 ch3-sps, 4 3-tr-bobbles, 8 ch1-sps, 12 5-dc-pop

rnd 6 (E) Begin with a standing st around any first ch-3-space:

*4 hdc around the next ch3-sp, 1 FPdc + ch 2 + 1 FPdc around the next st, 4 hdc around the next ch3-sp, 1 FPdc around the next st, 2 hdc around the next ch1-sp, skip the next 5-dc-pop, (2 hdc around the space between the next two 5-dc-pop, skip the next 5-dc-pop) x 2 times, 2 hdc around the next ch1-sp, 1 FPdc around next st; rep from * til end; fo

- 64 hdc, 16 FPdc, 4 ch2-sps,

rnd 7 (A) Begin with a standing stitch around any given:

*1 hdc + ch 2 + 1 hdc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPdc around the next st, 1 hdc in the next 18 sts, 1 FPdc around the next st; rep from * til end, fo.

- 80 hdc, 4 ch2-sps, 8 FPdc

rnd 8 (D) Begin with a standing stitch around any given:

*1 dc + ch 2 + 1 dc around the next ch2-sp, 1 FPtr around the next 2 sts, 1 dc in the next 18 sts, 1 FPtr around the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- 80 dc, 4 ch2-sps, 16 FPtr

rnd 9 (C) Begin with a standing stitch around any given:

*1 sc + ch 2 + 1 sc around the next ch2-sp, 1 sc in the next 24 sts; rep from * til end, fo.

- 26 sc, 4 ch2-sps
