## About The Design

Week nine has arrived and we are now about to begin our stroll through the last six rounds of this beautiful framing of our five floral squares. After this week we will have finished their transformation into stunningly textured octagons with lots of sweetness, popcorns, puffs and bobbles.

Either make one round at a time for each five pieces: or eagerly do all six rounds for your favorite one before doing the others. No matter what way you choose to stroll; I know it's gonna be awesome.

After finishing the framings on all five pieces you should now have five large octagons: the Ponding Lily-, the Oh I Adore-, the Island Lily-, The L.A. Sunflower- and lastly the A Little Something Octagon.

All absolutely stunning and oh so rich in texture.

## Yow Will $\mathcal{N e o d}^{\text {Wed }}$

## Yarn

For the pillow we have used Must-Have; a 4 ply yarn in 100\% mercerised cotton with a lovely shimmer that comes in 50 grams balls with 125 meters /137 yards.

For the blanket I have used Super Must-Have; a bulky weight yarn in $100 \%$ mercerised cotton with the same lovely smooth shimmer and comes in 100 grams balls with 115 meters/125 yards.

## Tools

A 3 mm crochet hook for the pillow or a 6 mm for the blanket
A darning needle
A pair of scissors

## Measurements

The Oh I Adore Square will measure $12,5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12,5 \mathrm{~cm}$ unblocked in Must-Have, and $23 \mathrm{~cm} \times 23 \mathrm{~cm}$ unblocked in Super Must-Have.

The finished pillow will fit a $50 \mathrm{~cm} \times 50 \mathrm{~cm}$ pillow insert. The finished blanket will measure $130 \mathrm{~cm} \times 130 \mathrm{~cm}$ (and 160 cm on the diagonal).

## Part 9. The Framing: Part 2

CONTINUE MAKING AROUND ALL FIVE SQUARES EXCEPT THE THUMBELINAS

Colorways: (Sunlight/Sea/Woods)

## Special stitches used:

dc3bobble (three double crochet bobble)
tr3bobble (three treble crochet bobble)
puff (puff stitch)
dc4pop (four double crochet popcorn)

## THE PATTERN

rnd 1 (Limestone/Limestone/Eucalyptus) Begin in any first sc (from rnd 5 of the Framing: Part 1) placed around the ch2-sp after a first dc3bobble:

* 1 sc in the next 10 sts, 1 hdc in the next 15 sts; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st

Check point 1. The first hdc will be made in the FPsc (rnd 5) that is placed around the fifth dc3bobble

Check point 2. The 15th hdc will be made in the FPsc (rnd 5) that is placed around the second dc4pop

- Per side: 10 sc, 15 hdc
rnd 2 (Pearl/Ecru/Ecru) Begin in any first hdc:
*(1 hdc in the next st, ch 1, skip the next st) x 7 times, 1 hdc in the next st, skip the next 4 sts, 1 tr3bobble + ch $3+1$ tr $3 b o b b l e+c h 3$ in next st, 1 tr3bobble + ch $3+1$ tr3bobble in the next st, skip the next 4 st; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st
- Per side: 8 hdc, 7 ch1-sps, 4 tr3bobbles, 3 ch3-sps


## THE FRAMING: PART 2 CONTINUED

rnd 3 (Cream/Cream/Rosé) Begin around any second ch3-sp of a corner:
*1 sc + 1 hdc + ch 1 + 1 hdc + 1 sc around the next ch3-sp, 1 FPsc around the next st, 4 sc around the next ch3-sp, skip the next tr3bobble, 1 FPdc around the next st, (skip the next ch1-sp, 1 puff in the next hdc + ch 1) x 5 times, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 puff in the next hdc, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPdc around the next st, skip the next tr3bobble, 4 sc around the next ch3-sp, 1 FPsc around the next st; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st

- Per side: 10 sc, 2 hdc, 2 FPsc, 2 FPdc, 8 ch1-sps, 6 puffs
rnd 4 (Old Pink/lce Blue/Pearl) Begin around any top ch1-sp:
*1 sc + ch $1+1$ sc around the next ch1-sp, 1 sc in the next 7 sts, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc + ch 1, skip the next st, (1 dc3bobble + ch 2 around the next ch1-sp, skip the next st) $\times 4$ times, 1 dc3bobble around the next ch1-sp + ch 1, skip the next st, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc, 1 sc in next 7 sts; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st
- Per side: 5 dc3bobbles, 5 ch1-sps, 2 FPdc, 16 sc
rnd 5 (Pearl/Limestone/Clay) Begin around any corner ch1-sp:
* $1 \mathrm{sc}+\mathrm{ch} 1+1 \mathrm{sc}$ around the next ch1-sp, skip the next st (hidden), 1 sc in the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc, (skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPhdc around the next dc3bobble, 1 hdc around the next ch1-sp) x 4 times, 1 FPhdc around the next dc3bobble, skip the next ch1-sp, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc, skip the next st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 3 sts, 1 sc in the next 2 sts; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st
- Per side: 6 sc, 1 ch1-sp, 10 hdc, $4 d c, 2$ FPdc, 5 FPhdc


## THE FRAMING: PART 2 CONTINUED

rad 6 (Cream/Ecru/Eucalyptus) Begin in any first sc placed after a corner ch1-sp:

* 1 hic in the next 8 sts, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc, 1 hic in the next 9 sts, 1 FPdc around the next FPdc, 1 hd in the next 8 sts, ch 2, skip the next ch1-sp; rep from * til end, close with an invisible join to the second st
- Per side: 25 hd, 2 FPdc, 1 ch2-sp

Well done, your framing part 2 is finished! Please remember to make these six rounds
for all of the five larger squares.



## Closing wards

Well done lovely! You have now finished part nine of the Island Stroll CAL and turning your stunning squares into octagons. We hope you've had lots of fun and enjoyed all the textured crochet this week had to offer.

Your finished octagon should now measure (unblocked, lightly stretched) approximately $60 \mathrm{~cm} \times 60 \mathrm{~cm}$ for the blanket, and 35 cm x 35 cm for the pillow.

Before you move on to next week make sure that you have the following parts finished: your five large octagons along with four Thumbelina squares if you are making the blanket, or five if you are making the pillow, cause for week 10 we are gonna do seperate patterns depending on which project you are working on.
