## Thread With Love Fingerless Mitts

## Yow Will $\mathcal{N e o d}_{\text {e ed }}$

1 skein of Sugar Baby Alpaca by Wool And The Gang: Cameo Rose; A 3,5mmhook (E7/4:9); Yarn needle; Scissor.

Note! Depending on your tension you might need to use two skeins.

Skill level: Intermediate


## Rib:

Finish each round with ch 1 (the turning stitch), this doesn't count as a stitch.

## Mitten:

The V-puffs are always worked in the $V$-puffs from the previous round!

## Mitten:

Finish each round with a slip stitch in the first hoc and then make a standing hic (or a ch 1 as the turning stitch), these doesn't count as stitches!

Therefore: note that the slip stitch is made in the first hic and not in the turning hoc.

## US-terminology

st - stitch
rind - round
inc - increase (work 2 stitches in 1) dec - decrease (work 1 stitch over 2 stitches)

BLO - Back Loops Only
BP - Back Post
th - turning chain
fo - fasten off
sI st - slip stitch
ch - chain stitch
ch sp - chain space
sc - single crochet
hd - half double crochet

## V-puff - V-shaped puff stitch

The V-puff is made out of two puff stitches that are both worked into the same stitch to form a heart like shape.

How to: Yarn over and insert your hook into the specified stitch. Yarn over again and pull up a long loop. (Yarn over and insert your hook into the same stitch. Yarn over again and pull up a long loop) two more times. Yarn over and pull through all 7 loops on your hook. Ch 1 to close the puff stitch. Make another one exactly the same way into the same space.

## The Pattern

## THE RIB

Ch 12 + turn.

Row 1. Begin in the second chain from your hook:
1 sc in the next 11 sts, 1 tach + turn

- 11 sc


## Row 2-31.

1 BLOsc in the next 11 sts, 1 tech + turn

- 11 BLOsc: for 32 rows in total

Place the two short sides against each other and slip stitch the sides together. Turn your mitts inside out and chain 2.

Continue on the long-side of the rib (that is now shaped as a circle) for the mitten pattern.

## THE LEFT SIDE MITT

## Rind 1.

1 hoc in the next 33 sts
$-33 h d c$

## Rind 2.

1 BPhdc around the next 33 sts

33 BPhdc

## Rind 3.

Repeat rad 1
$-33 h d c$

## Rind 4.

Repeat rind 2
-33 BPhdc

## THREAD WITH LOVE FINGERLESS MITTS CONTINUED

## Rnd 5.

1 hdc in the next 12 sts, skip the next st, (1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next 2 sts) $\times 2$ times,, 1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 12 sts

- 24 hdc, 3 V-puffs


## Rnd 6.

Repeat rnd 5

- 24 hdc, 3 V-puffs


## Rnd 7.

1 hdc in the next 9 sts, skip the next st, (1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next 2 sts) x 4 times, 1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 12 sts

- 18 hdc, 5 V-puffs


## Rnd 8-11.

Repeat rnd 7

- 18 hdc, 5 V-puffs: for 4 rnds in total


## Rnd 12.

Repeat rnd 5

- 24 hdc, 3 V-puffs


## Rnd 13.

1 hdc in the next 6 sts, ch 8 , skip the next 6 sts, 1 hdc in the next st, skip the next st, ( $1 \vee$-puff in the next st, skip the next 2 sts) $\times 2$ times, 1 V -puff in the next st, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next 13 sts

- 20 hdc, 3 V-puffs


## THREAD WITH LOVE FINGERLESS MITTS CONTINUED

Rnd 14. Note that this round is simply hdc:s all around; but the placement can feel is a bit tricky.:
1 hdc in the next 6 sts, 8 hdc around the next ch8-sp, 1 hdc in the next hdc, 1 hdc around the next $1 \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, (1 hdc around the space between the 2 V-puffs, 2 hdc around the next ch1-sp) x 2 times, 1 hdc around the space between 2 V -puffs, 1 hdc around the space after the next $V$-puff, 1 hdc in the next 13 sts (begin in the hidden st)
-36 hdc

## Rnd 15.

1 hdc in the next 8 sts, 1 dec hdc over the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next st, 1 dec hdc over the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 23 sts
$-34 h d c$

## Rnd 16.

1 hdc in the next 34 sts

34 hdc

## Rnd 17.

1 BPhdc around the next 34 sts
-34 BPhdc

## Rnd 18.

Repeat rnd 16
$-34 h d c$

## Rnd 19.

Repeat rnd 17

- 34 BPhdc


## Rnd 20.

1 sc in the next 34 sts, close with an invisible join to the second st

## THE RIGHT SIDE MITT

Work up a rib as previously and follow the pattern for round 1-12 of the left side mitt.

## Rnd 13.

1 hdc in the next 12 sts, skip the next st, (1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next 2 sts) x 2 times, 1 V-puff in the next st, skip the next st, 1 hdc in the next st, ch 8 , skip the next 6 sts, 1 hdc in the next 6 sts (the first is to be placed around the ch1-sp and the second in the hidden st)

- 20 hdc, 3 V-puffs

Rnd 14. Note that this round is simply hdc:s all around; but the placement can feel is a bit tricky:
1 hdc in the next 12 sts, 1 hdc around the next ch1-sp, ( 1 hdc around the space between the 2 V-puffs, 2 hdc around the next ch1-sp) x 2 times, 1 hdc around the space between 2 V -puffs, 1 hdc around the space after the next V-puff, 1 hdc in the next hdc, 8 hdc around the next ch8-sp, 1 hdc in the next 6 sts
-36 hdc

## Rnd 15.

1 hdc in the next 24 sts, 1 dec hdc over the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next st, 1 dec hdc over the next 2 sts, 1 hdc in the next 7 sts
$-34 h d c$

## Rnd 16.

1 hdc in the next 34 sts
$-34 h d c$

## Rnd 17.

1 BPhdc around the next 34 sts

- 34 BPhdc


## Rad 18.

Repeat rind 16
$-34 h d c$

## Rind 19.

Repeat rind 17

- 34 BPhdc


## Rad 20.

1 sc in the next 34 sts, close with an invisible join to the second st

- 34 sc
